The EVIW programme reflects current trends and new developments in veterinary immunology. There are three Plenary Sessions comprising keynote lectures delivered by invited, internationally-recognised experts, and six Concurrent Sessions that include invited speakers and presentations from selected delegate abstracts. There are two dedicated Poster Sessions to allow ample time for in depth discussions and personal meetings.
